KANSAS CITY

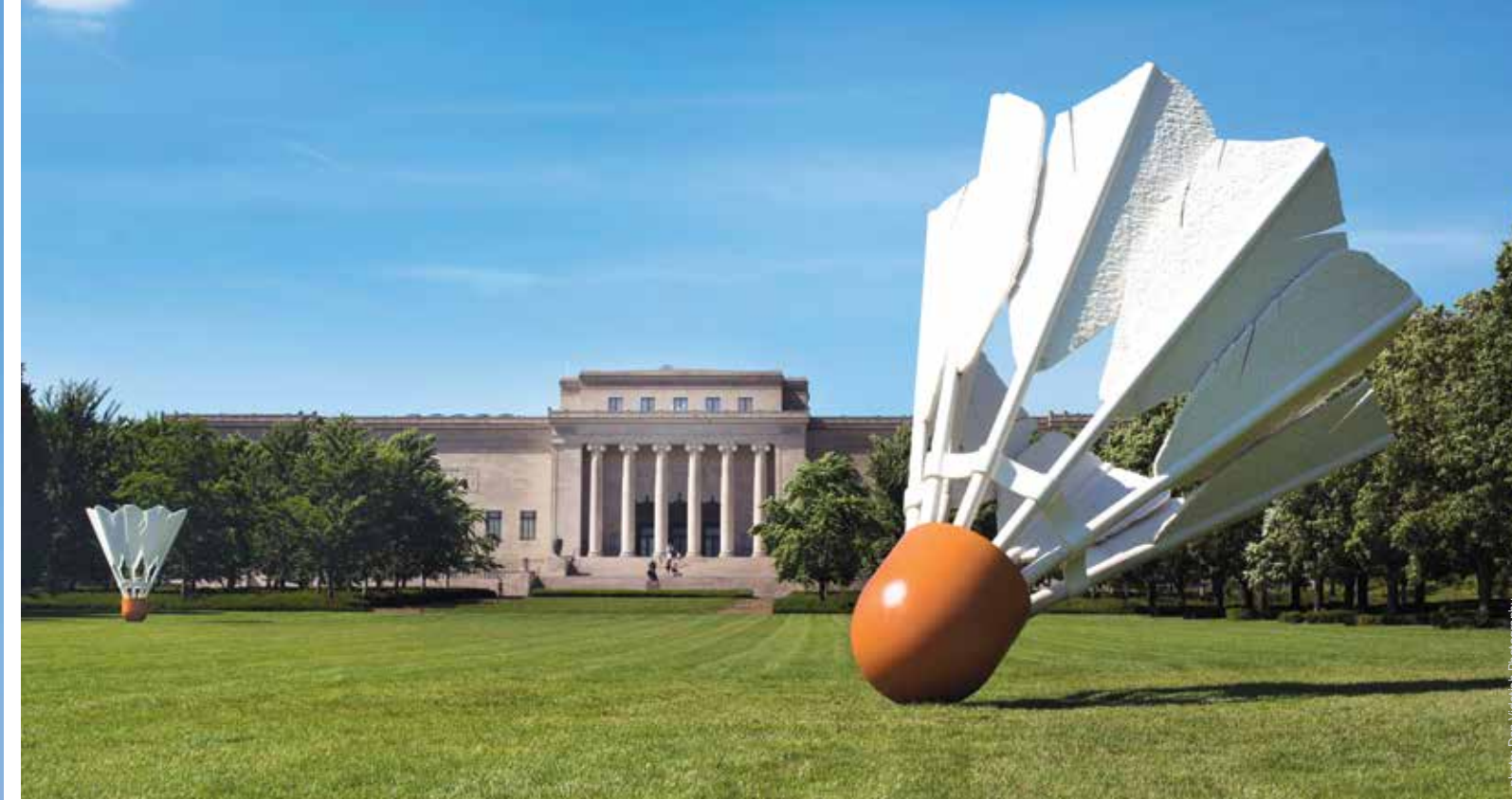
