As of 2015, the National Center for Charitable Statistics reported that over 1.5 million tax-exempt organizations had been recognized by the IRS in the United States. This includes an estimated 70,000 trade and professional associations, 100,000 foundations, and over 310,000 congregations. One thing across non-profits is true; effective leadership is key to supporting the mission and goals of the organization. From working with a board of directors to volunteer committees and supporting a non-profit mission - leading these organizations present common, mission-critical challenges.
