Notes:

- Students must be seen by a Bloch School advisor before enrolling in courses. The Bloch Student Services Office offers a combination of walk-in advising and advising by appointment. Please call 816-235-2215 for current hours.
- Minor is open to Bloch School students in accounting and non-Bloch School students.
- Students pursuing the minor in entrepreneurship are limited to 30 hours of Bloch School courses.
- Students must achieve a minimum GPA of 2.25 in all entrepreneurship courses.
- All 18 hours must be complete at the Bloch School; approved major-related electives must be completed at UMKC. The major-related course should be consistent with the student's entrepreneurial focus. These electives must be selected from an approved list of courses offered by the school that houses their major discipline.
- Entrepreneurship Scholars is a special program for aspiring entrepreneurs which requires an application and acceptance. The two-semester program admits new participants in fall and spring semesters. Students accepted to this program will enroll in ENT 329, one in each semester of Entrepreneurship Scholars participation, for a total of 6 hours of credit across the two terms.
