*ENT 315 is the preferred class for students selecting an Entrepreneurship elective.

Notes:

- Meet with an advisor to officially declare the minor.
- Students classified as 'pre-' can enter the minor but it cannot be added to the student's program of study until a major has been declared.
- Transfer students with equivalent course credit will be allowed to apply up to 6 hours of approved course work and a minimum of 12 hours must be completed at UMKC.
- BLA students are eligible for this minor.
- Bloch School students are not eligible for this minor.
- Students pursuing a minor in business are limited to 30 hours of Bloch School courses.
- Students must achieve a minimum GPA of 2.25 in all Bloch School courses.
- Bloch School courses numbered 300-399 require a minimum of 45 completed hours to enroll. ENT 315 is the exception with no specific number of hours needed for enrollment. Courses numbered 400-499 require a minimum of 60 completed hours to enroll.
- Students pursuing the minor are not eligible to take program capstone courses including ENT 462 and MGT 471.
